

On Tuesday, January 19, 2016, a mix of native plant seeds were sprayed around Horse Creek Dam (HCD) in a process known as *hydroseeding*. The intent of this project was not only to stabilize the soil along the banks and slopes of HCD, but also to propagate the numbers of native plants in this area.

Listed below are the species of seed which were laid around HCD. It cannot be determined which species will proliferate, if any, we will have to wait and observe the area for results.
